# A. Review 2017 SBAC Data

The AFBA Board of Directors reviewed AFBA's academic results. AFBA Elementary was #1 in AF CT schools on the SBAC. AFBA Middle School struggled this year which is not a surprise but there is a great deal of optimism for AFBA Middle School with the new principal, Simon Obas. AFBA Middle has suffered with morale and school culture issues. One of Simon Obas's strengths is school culture. Mr. Jobe has

attended the parent meetings at AFBA-Middle and is optimistic with the parents' reaction to Mr. Obas. The first day of school is August 14. Board members are encouraged to go to AFBA-Middle at 7 a.m. to be there to greet the students on the first day.

Choice attrition data is comprised of students who have left the school. This data presented does not include those students who left the school for reasons deemed "acceptable" such as moving out of the state.

AFBA Middle math results are mixed. 5th and 6th graders increased their math results while 7th and 8th graders decreased.

There was discussion on the AFBA Elementary who are participating in Horizons at Sacred Heart this summer. The group expressed an interest in tracking Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) progress.
