### II. Open Session For Public Comment

### III. Dacia Toll Presentation

Ms. Dacia Toll reviewed highlights from the 2014-15 school year and presented AF's organizational priorities for 2015-16 and the Arc of the Year. Top highlights included SBAC test preparation, continued reduction in suspension rates, 100 percent college acceptance rates at AF Brooklyn High and Amistad High and results of advocacy efforts. Ms. Toll also discussed AF Greenfield.

Ms. Toll explained AF's organizational priorities for the 2015-16 school year including: 1) Student Thinking and Engagement 2) Strong Response to Student Data & Work 3) Vibrant School Culture 4) College-Ready Bar 5) Talent Practices and Pipeline. Ms. Toll also outlined the Arc of the Year which focuses on answering the essential questions:

**RIGOR** | Are all students grappling with content aligned to the college ready bar?

**FOCUS** | Are all students focused on the work of the lesson from start to finish? Is the tone positive?

**INVESTMENT** | Would students stay if they had the choice to leave?

**THINKING** | Does instruction unleash the intellect of scholars? Are students doing the lift?

**FEEDBACK** | Are students rapidly improving the quality of their work based on clear, actionable feedback?

#### **IV. Board Governance Update**

The Governance Committee of Amistad/Elm City College Prep discussed their recent work including a review of the charter bylaws, the committee's 2015-16 priorities. Ms. Pat Sweet thanked Ms. Marnie Halsey for her steadfast commitment towards improved practices and updating governing documents.

#### **V. AF through College**

Adam Kendis, Network Director of College Success, moderated a panel of five Amistad High School alumni who are currently in college. Students shared their personal experiences and Mr. Kendis described the evolution of the college readiness program at AF's four high schools.

#### **VI. School Culture**

Shannon Garfield, Senior Director of Special Services, presented on the priorities and strategies that will be used to ensure vibrant, joyful school cultures in the 2015-16 school year. Ms. Garfield simulated a classroom environment and engaged the Board of Directors in a series of precise directions.

#### **VII. Individual Board Breakout Sessions with Regional Superintendents**

Regional Superintendents Marc Michaelson, Morgan Barth, and Jeff Sudmyer, joined by Dacia Toll and Shannon Garfield, met with the boards of their schools and discussed individual school performance and school leadership within the context of network academic achievement and school culture.
