#### **Background on Navigator:**

Navigator is an *AF Accelerate* open source program designed to support traditional public and charter schools in accelerating their math and/or ELA achievement by sharing Achievement First's curriculum and providing intensive coaching support to schools participating in the program. Navigator is a growing national program, serving over 60 schools around the country.

#### Summary:

Navigator is seeking a data analyst (contract-role) to perform regular reporting and analysis for our partner schools and program leaders in our Navigator Math Lessons, Math Stories, and Literature programs. The analyst will be responsible for collecting, cleaning, and analyzing and reporting on data from interim assessments that our partner schools administer throughout the school year. Navigator currently uses a central Microsoft SQL Server database to store all partner data and Tableau to generate reports. The ideal candidate is a creative problem solver with strong data analysis experience and excellent project and time management skills. This is a short-term consulting role that could possibly lead to a full-time position.



## **Responsibilities:**

- **Data cleaning** Clean incoming Excel data files from partner schools to ensure they are errorfree and loadable to our database
- **Database loading and maintenance** Load Excel data to our Microsoft SQL Server database through a simple import process; ensure the database is functioning properly
- **Regular reporting of interim assessment data** Create personalized reports using an existing template for our partner schools analyzing their interim assessment results, utilizing Tableau and PowerPoint

- Excellent personal organization, project management, and time management skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Experienced in Excel and PowerPoint
- Proficiency in Tableau required
- Basic understanding of SQL preferred
