- Work closely with our Systems & Data team to product manage all of the Greenfield Program's digital learning tools and online learning & assessment systems throughout their entire life cycle
- Create and manage processes to update internal documentation to ensure strong knowledge management
- Develop and/or lead training for Network and School Stakeholders so that all key players have the information and skills needed to effectively leverage tools and systems

• Plan for and manage product evaluation and implementation cycles that are rooted in data, stakeholder feedback and industry best practices
