Ninetythree percent of seniors at the school have been accepted into colleges or universities to date with a total of 600 acceptances. The school is currently preparing for upcoming testing by having teachers meet regularly with coaches and using data to give more feedback to students as they approach the end of the school year. Ms. Garfield shared that the girls' basketball team qualified for the state championship and that the boys basketball team qualified for the state tournament. Outdoor Track, Soccer, Boys Volleyball and Girls Lacrosse are scheduled to start next week. In student life, upcoming events include a Spring Concert in June, Senior Signing Day in May, and Graduation in June.

The school is also working closely with strategic planning on how best to address COVID-19. College Trips are being addressed based upon most up to date guidelines.

Jane Levin gave the personnel subcommittee report. The subcommittee met earlier in the week and will hold another meeting.

## VI. Financial Report

Laura Saverin gave the financial report. Little has changed since the last meeting, except that the state will not fund extra students above the enrollment cap.
